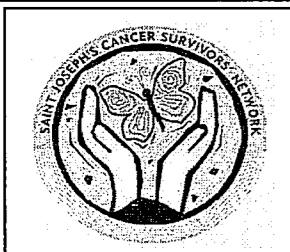

#### Purpose & Eligibility:

To offer two annual scholarships in recognition and honor of Margaret A. Riley's many career contributions on behalf of cancer survivorship.

One scholarship will be awarded to a cancer survivor\*, caregiver, or cancer survivorship volunteer.

A second scholarship will be awarded to an oncology professional\*\*.

Both scholarships are given to enable recipients to attend a cancer-related educational or support program of their choice to broaden their understanding of the cancer journey. Recipients from prior years must wait a year before they can apply again. The CSN hopes that you will bring back knowledge gained and share it with the CSN and the whole cancer community.
