### **Program Description**

There is an opportunity in ACPE Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) for theological students, ordained clergy, members of religious orders, and qualified lay people to receive supervision while they minister to people in crisis situations. Through intense involvement with supervisors, other students, people in crisis, and other professionals, CPE students are challenged to improve the quality of their pastoral relationships.

The ACPE CPE Program for January at the North Atlanta CPE Center is a four-week, full-time introduction to CPE. The program focuses on ministry to patients and families. Areas for clinical assignments include Saint Joseph's Hospital of Atlanta or one of the facilities of Presbyterian Homes of Georgia in Decatur or Buckhead. One-half unit of ACPE CPE credit is earned upon completion of the program. One-half unit of ACPE CPE is at least 60 hours of structured group and individual education accompanied by at least 180 hours of clinical practice in ministry.

The weekly schedule includes a didactic, two verbatim seminars, and a pastoral concern seminar. Each student is assigned a clinical area in their placement site and participates in the on-call duty rotation at Saint Joseph's Hospital. The unit begins with several days of orientation.

### **Program Fees**

1. The application fee is \$30 for one-half unit of ACPE CPE.
2. The application fee must accompany the application materials.
3. Tuition is \$275 for one-half unit of credit of ACE CPE.
