**Program Description:**

There is an opportunity in ACPE Clinical Pastoral Education ("CPE") for theological students, ordained clergy, members of religious orders, and qualified lay people to receive supervision while they minister to people in crisis situations. Through intense involvement with supervisors, other students, people in crisis, and other professionals, CPE students are challenged to improve the quality of their pastoral relationships.

The ACPE CPE Program for Summer 2009 at the North Atlanta CPE Center is a full-time, three-month introduction to CPE. The program focuses on ministry to patients and families. Areas for clinical assignments include Saint Joseph's Hospital of Atlanta and Presbyterian Homes of Georgia (Philips Tower and Calvin Court).

One unit of ACPE CPE credit is earned upon completion of the program. One unit of ACPE CPE is at least 100 hours of structured group and individual education accompanied by at least 300 hours of clinical practice in ministry.

Summer ACPE CPE groups meet for seminars four days of the week. Didactics, verbatim seminars, and a pastoral concerns seminar are included in these weekly meetings. Each student also meets for one hour of individual supervision each week. Each student is assigned a patient care area in their respective hospital and participates in the on-call duty rotation at their assigned hospital. The unit begins with several days of orientation.

**Program Fees**

1. The application fee is \$60 for one unit of ACPE CPE.
2. The application fee must accompany the application materials.
3. Tuition is \$450 for one unit of ACPE CPE.
