Cardiovascular Screening

Cardiovascular Screening is a program that reaches out to corporations, businesses, community groups and churches to provide education and screening for the early detection of cardiovascular disease.



Types of Screenings

Basic Cardiac Check

This screening includes cholesterol, blood sugar, blood pressure, weight, BMI and consultation with a health-care professional.

Cost \$30

Intermediate Cardiac Check

Includes cholesterol, LDL, HDL, cholesterol/HDL ratio, triglycerides, blood sugar, blood pressure, weight, BMI, and consultation with a health-care professional.

Cost \$50

Comprehensive Cardiac Check

Includes EKG, carotid ultrasound cholesterol, LDL, HDL, cholesterol/HDL ratio, triglycerides, blood sugar, blood pressure, weight, BMI, and consultation with a health-care professional.

Cost \$80

Blood Flow Assessment

This screening is designed to assess the arterial blood flow in the legs. People with peripheral vascular disease (PVD) have a higher risk for heart disease and stroke. The results are immediate and include a consultation with a health-care professional.

Cost \$20
